

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Read the manual before use and keep it for future reference.
- The chair is not intended for children, people with reduced motor skills, people with physical limitations, or people with reduced mental capacity. These people may only use the chair if they are under the constant supervision of a responsible adult or guardian.
- Do not use the chair if you suffer from osteoporosis, heart disease or disorder, fever, skin disease, people with heat sensitivity.
- Do not use the chair if you use a pacemaker or other electronic medical device.
- The chair is not suitable for pregnant women.
- · Consult a doctor before use.
- Do not use the chair if you are wet or have damp skin.
- The chair must not be used by children under 14 years of age without supervision.
- Do not use the chair if the power cord is damaged. Ask the service department or a qualified person to replace the power cord.
- Keep children away from adjustable parts of the chair.
- Use only a properly grounded outlet for power.
- Unplug the chair from the power supply after use or before cleaning.
- Use the chair only in accordance with the manual.
- Do not use unapproved accessories or modifications.
- We recommend a maximum of 20 minutes of continuous massage operation.
- Do not use the chair if it is damaged, the leather cover is damaged, or sharp edges appear on the chair.
- Protect the chair from impacts, falls, or other physical damage.
- The chair is not intended for sleeping.
- Do not use under the influence of alcohol, drugs, or medications that may negatively affect judgment or motor functions.
- Do not use within 1 hour of eating.
- Only plug into outlets that meet specifications.
- Do not handle the power cord with damp or wet hands.
- Keep the chair and all its parts away from water. There is a risk of electric shock.
- Do not pull the power cord.
- Protect the power cord from damage.
- Do not clean the electrical parts with a damp or wet cloth.
- In case of damage, stop using the product immediately and have the defect repaired before using it again.
- If you feel unwell or uncomfortable, stop using it immediately and consult a doctor.
- Storage temperature: 5°C 40°C
- Humidity: 20% 80%, in a well-ventilated room free from corrosive gases

MAINTENANCE

- For cleaning and maintenance, follow the instructions in the manual.
- After use, turn off the main switch.
- Do not use if the power cord is damaged.
- Store the chair in a dry and clean room, disconnected from the power supply.
- Do not store in a room with high temperatures, humidity or near open fire or flames.
- Do not expose to prolonged sunlight.
- Clean the surface with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use aggressive cleaning agents.
- The mechanical parts do not require any specific maintenance.
- To move the chair on an uneven surface, it is necessary to lift the chair.

OPERATING ENVIRONMENT

- Do not use in rooms with high humidity such as saunas, swimming pools, etc.
- Do not use if the room temperature changes suddenly and drastically.
- Do not use in a room with high dust content.
- Do not use in a room with poor ventilation or poor air flow.


ADDITIONAL INFORMATION


- It is normal to hear the motor running during use.
- If the controller is not working properly, check all connections and the power switch.
- The chair will automatically turn off after the set operating time. In case of long continuous operation, the temperature sensor may turn off the chair. In this case, you need to wait for the chair to cool down for approximately 30 minutes.


ARMRESTS ASSEMBLY


- After starting, use the control to adjust the backrest to the lowest position (lay the backrest down).
- Connect the cables and attach the air hoses (Fig. 1).
- After connecting all cables and hoses, lift the armrest and hook it into the hook on the frame (Fig. 2).





- Attach the roller at the end of the armrest into the hole (Fig. 3).
- Push the armrest down and secure with 2x M6*16 screws (Fig. 4).







CALF SUPPORT ATTACHMENT


Connect the cables and air hoses (Fig. 1).

After connecting the cables and hoses, open the bracket on both sides of the frame (Fig. 2).

Attach the backrest to the open brackets and then secure the brackets with 2x M15*15 screws (Fig. 3).










ATTACHING THE CONTROL PANEL HOLDER

- Attach the bracket to the hole on the right side of the armrest using the M5*16 screw (Fig. 1).
- Attach the cap to the screw (Fig. 2).
- Make sure the bracket is attached correctly (Fig. 3).








PLACEMENT

Make sure there is at least 10 cm of free space behind the chair.

Do not expose the chair to high temperatures, such as continuous sunlight, heating or heaters. We recommend using a mat to protect the floor. The mat should cover the entire area where the chair is in contact with the floor.



MOVING

Lifting


Ask another person for help. Move the chair if it is placed on a floor that can be easily damaged. Move the chair carefully and place it down carefully.




Make sure there are no obstacles in the path. Tilt the chair back to an angle of approximately 45°. If you tilt the chair more, there is a risk of tipping over.

Before moving, make sure the chair is switched off and disconnected from the power supply. There must be no one on the chair. When transporting on wheels, do not drive over obstacles higher than 2 mm and wider than 5 mm

Move the chair carefully and then put it down carefully.






BACK AND HEAD PILLOWS

The cushions are connected by a zipper. If the massage intensity is high, you can use the pillows to reduce the massage intensity. We recommend leaving the head cushion attached.

The back cushion is attached to the backrest by a zipper (1).

The head and back cushions are connected by a zipper (2).




WARNING

Always check the safety of the surroundings before use. Pets and children should not be allowed around the chair.




Before use, make sure that there are no foreign objects in the ventilation openings and moving parts of the chair. Protect the surface from damage.




CONNECTING TO POWER SOURCE



Plug the power cord into the chair.




Plug the power cord into the outlet.




Start using the main switch.






HEATED SHAWL

You can use the shawl to heat (1) area: shoulders, back, hips or abdomen, depending on the location.






Use in the lumbar and back area.










- 1. Power Switch: Turns the massage chair on/off
- 2. Voice Control: Hold for 3 seconds to turn on/off voice control. Press to wake up the function.
- 3. Zero Gravity I: Press to switch the chair to Zero Gravity I.
- 4. Length adjustment: Hold the button to adjust the length of the back massage (lengthen) and leg massage (shorten). After finishing, the foot massage mechanism will automatically detect the height.
- 5. Increase foot size: Hold to increase the size of the foot. Release the button to end the adjustment.
- 6. Decrease foot size: Hold to decrease the size of the foot. Release the button to end the adjustment.
- 7. Height adjustment: Hold the button to adjust the length of the back massage (shorten) and leg massage (lengthen). After finishing, the foot massage mechanism will automatically detect the height.
- 8. Zero Gravity II: Press to switch the chair to Zero Gravity II position.
- 9. Automatic Massage: Press to switch to automatic massage.
- 10. Massage Intensity: Turn the knob to the right to increase the intensity of the 4D massage, turn it to the left to decrease the intensity of the 4D massage.




Press the button on the remote control or on the chair to start/stop the chair.




- 2. After starting, select the massage intensity: gentle , comfortable , strong . If you do not select an intensity within 5 minutes of switching on, the chair will automatically turn off.
- 3. Select the automatic program to automatically adjust the angle. To skip, press the SKIP button.




4. Wait until the body shape detection is complete. You can skip the detection by pressing the SKIP button.



If the position of the shoulder massage heads is correct, press OK to start the massage. To adjust the position of the shoulder massage heads, press the buttons and then confirm with OK. If no operation is performed for 20 seconds, the program will start with the current position of the shoulder massage heads.





Pause (only works when the program is running)

After the function has started, press the button to pause the program. All functions will stop.

Press the button to start.

Note: When the program is paused, all functions will stop working except the off button.


Automatic program



- (1) Select automatic program
- (2) Select automatic program by pressing on the left side of the control panel.

There are 20 automatically preset programs to choose from: Total Relax, Chinese Massage, Fatigue Recovery, Gentle Waves Rub, Thai Massage, Meridian Treatment, Neck & Shoulder Care, Hips&legs Fit, Waist Care, Leg & foot Relieve, Superior Enjoyable, President Cosy, Keep Fit, Office Regimen, Health Recharge, Energy Boost, Lunch Break, Warming and detox, Sport Recovery, Sweet Dream.

(3) Select a massage and start by pressing START.






You can set your own massage using the button on the left side. You can set: massage technique, massage area, 4D intensity, palm massage, massage width, massage speed, air massage and other functions.

1. There are 11 types of massage to choose from: kneading, tapping I, tapping II, kneading and tapping, Shiatsu I, Shiatsu II, gripping, 4D I, 4D III, 4D IV. (You can use the arrows to switch the displayed menu)



Seat position adjustment

Press the button on the left side to enter the chair position adjustment interface: leg extension/shortening, leg lift/lower, chair lift/lower, backrest lift/lower, zero gravity I, zero gravity II.



1. Zero gravity

Zero I	The chair automatically adjusts the position of the backrest and footrest to the zero gravity position I.
Zero II	The chair automatically adjusts the position of the backrest and footrest to the zero gravity position II.

Raise the backrest and lower the footrest: Hold down the button to raise the backrest and lower the footrest. After the adjustment is completed, the chair detects the user's height.



Lower the backrest and raise the footrest: Hold down the button to lower the backrest and raise the footrest. After the adjustment is completed, the chair detects the user's height.

Health Detection


On the left side, select to enter health detection. After selecting the function, press place your middle finger on the sensor and wait until the measurement is completed.





Recommended program


After detection, your heart rate, blood oxygenation and fatigue level will be displayed. After detection, you can have the program generated by confirming or exiting the settings.



If the detection was not successful, you can repeat the test or exit the interface.



CLEANING


Clean the leather with a dry, soft cloth. Do not use harsh cleaning agents. If you use leather products, follow the manufacturer's instructions.

To clean synthetic leather, use the following solution:

• warm water containing 3% - 5% neutral detergent.

Wipe the dirty area with a soft cloth dampened in the solution and then dry.

Always dry the chair with a cloth and then let it dry naturally. Do not use a hair dryer or other heat sources.

All Warranty Conditions stated here under determine Warranty Coverage and Warranty Claim Procedure. Conditions of Warranty and Warranty Claims are governed by Act No. 89/2012 Coll. Civil Code, and Act No. 634/1992 Coll., Consumer Protection, as amended, also in cases that are not specified by these Warranty rules.

The seller is SEVEN SPORT s.r.o. with its registered office in Strakonická street 1151/2c, Prague 150 00, Company Registration Number: 26847264, registered in the Trade Register at Regional Court in Prague, Section C, Insert No. 116888.

According to valid legal regulations it depends whether the Buyer is the End Customer or not.

"The Buyer who is the End Customer" or simply the "End Customer" is the legal entity that does not conclude and execute the Contract in order to run or promote his own trade or business activities.

"The Buyer who is not the End Customer" is a Businessman that buys Goods or uses services for the purpose of using the Goods or services for his own business activities. The Buyer conforms to the General Purchase Agreement and business conditions.

These Conditions of Warranty and Warranty Claims are an integral part of every Purchase Agreement made between the Seller and the Buyer. All Warranty Conditions are valid and binding, unless otherwise specified in the Purchase Agreement, in the Amendment to this Contract or in another written agreement.

Warranty Conditions

Warranty Period

The Seller provides the Buyer a 24 months Warranty for Goods Quality, unless otherwise specified in the Certificate of Warranty, Invoice, Bill of Delivery or other documents related to the Goods. The legal warranty period provided to the Consumer is not affected.

By the Warranty for Goods Quality, the Seller guarantees that the delivered Goods shall be, for a certain period of time, suitable for regular or contracted use, and that the Goods shall maintain its regular or contracted features.

Batteries

6-month battery warranty – we guarantee that battery's nominal capacity does not fall below 70% of its total capacity within 6 months of the product's sale.

The Warranty does not cover defects resulting from (if applicable):

- User's fault, i.e. product damage caused by unqualified repair work, improper assembly, insufficient insertion of seat post into frame, insufficient tightening of pedals and cranks
- Improper maintenance
- Mechanical damages
- Regular use (e.g. wearing out of rubber and plastic parts, moving mechanisms, joints, wear of brake pads/blocks, chain, tires, cassette/multi wheel etc.)
- · Unavoidable event, natural disaster
- Adjustments made by unqualified person
- Improper maintenance, improper placement, damages caused by low or high temperature, water, inappropriate pressure, shocks, intentional changes in design or construction etc.

Warranty Claim Procedure

The Buyer is obliged to check the Goods delivered by the Seller immediately after taking the responsibility for the Goods and its damages, i.e. immediately after its delivery. The Buyer must check the Goods so that he discovers all the defects that can be discovered by such check.

When making a Warranty Claim the Buyer is obliged, on request of the Seller, to prove the purchase and validity of the claim by the Invoice or Bill of Delivery that includes the product's serial number, or eventually by the documents without the serial number. If the Buyer does not prove the validity of the Warranty Claim by these documents, the Seller has the right to reject the Warranty Claim.

If the Buyer gives notice of a defect that is not covered by the Warranty (e.g. in the case that the Warranty Conditions were not fulfilled or in the case of reporting the defect by mistake etc.), the Seller is eligible to require a compensation for all the costs arising from the repair. The cost shall be calculated according to the valid price list of services and transport costs.

If the Seller finds out (by testing) that the product is not damaged, the Warranty Claim is not accepted. The Seller reserves the right to claim a compensation for costs arising from the false Warranty Claim.

In case the Buyer makes a claim about the Goods that is legally covered by the Warranty provided by the Seller, the Seller shall fix the reported defects by means of repair or by the exchange of the damaged part or product for a new one. Based on the agreement of the Buyer, the Seller has the right to exchange the defected Goods for a fully compatible Goods of the same or better technical characteristics. The Seller is entitled to choose the form of the Warranty Claim Procedures described in this paragraph.

The Seller shall settle the Warranty Claim within 30 days after the delivery of the defective Goods, unless a longer period has been agreed upon. The day when the repaired or exchanged Goods is handed over to the Buyer is considered to be the day of the Warranty Claim settlement. When the Seller is not able to settle the Warranty Claim within the agreed period due to the specific nature of the Goods defect, he and the Buyer shall make an agreement about an alternative solution. In case such agreement is not made, the Seller is obliged to provide the Buyer with a financial compensation in the form of a refund.
